5. Feedback Items

- a. Start of the school year
 - Staggered Start 3rd year. Kids find their homerooms, get their textbooks, dry run through the schedule. It helps reduce anxiety in students, especially in grade 7. It is good to have a break day for younger kids in there to decompress and makes the grade 7 students feel special
- 6. **Spirit Week** Blue Day Is held the first week of school, the big day is Blue Day and it ends with a dance on Friday. Helps to build lots of community.
- 7. Meet the Staff Open House Lower key this year. Thinking about having a bigger event in June to welcome incoming students. Got lots of positive feedback. A suggestion made to have maps and more signage.
- Capital purchase plan Want to have the same chairs for all students. They have increased in price. It was 75 chairs @ \$52 and now is \$70 approximately. 85 chairs will be ordered this year. Ovens in the Home Ec room from Mccoy will need to be purchased. Discussion on any purchases: Buying go pro equipment, continuous purchase of shop supplies and replacing the band room chairs.
- 9. **Options** planning to send out an email in the summer with the available options and then make choices closer to the beginning of school. There has been many requests for schedule changes and some can be done but not all.
