#### **Final Exam Information**

Morning busing will run as usual for all Final Exams. All exams begin at **9:00am**. For all exams, students must remain in their exam room until 10:15. Following this time they are dismissed and have the following options available to them:

- 1. Stay on the school grounds with supervision until the arrival of buses. Buses depart at 11:15 each day.
- 2. Arrange for a ride from a parent or other party. Students and parents do not need to notify the office to sign your student out as students are dismissed at 10:15 or at the completion of their exam.
- 3. Students who normally walk, ride, or have a scooter can leave the school grounds when they have completed their exam following 10:15 dismissal.

Please note students can not choose to leave the school grounds to go to the convenience store and then return to take a bus home.
